TrafficJet™ Longstore Process

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Requirements

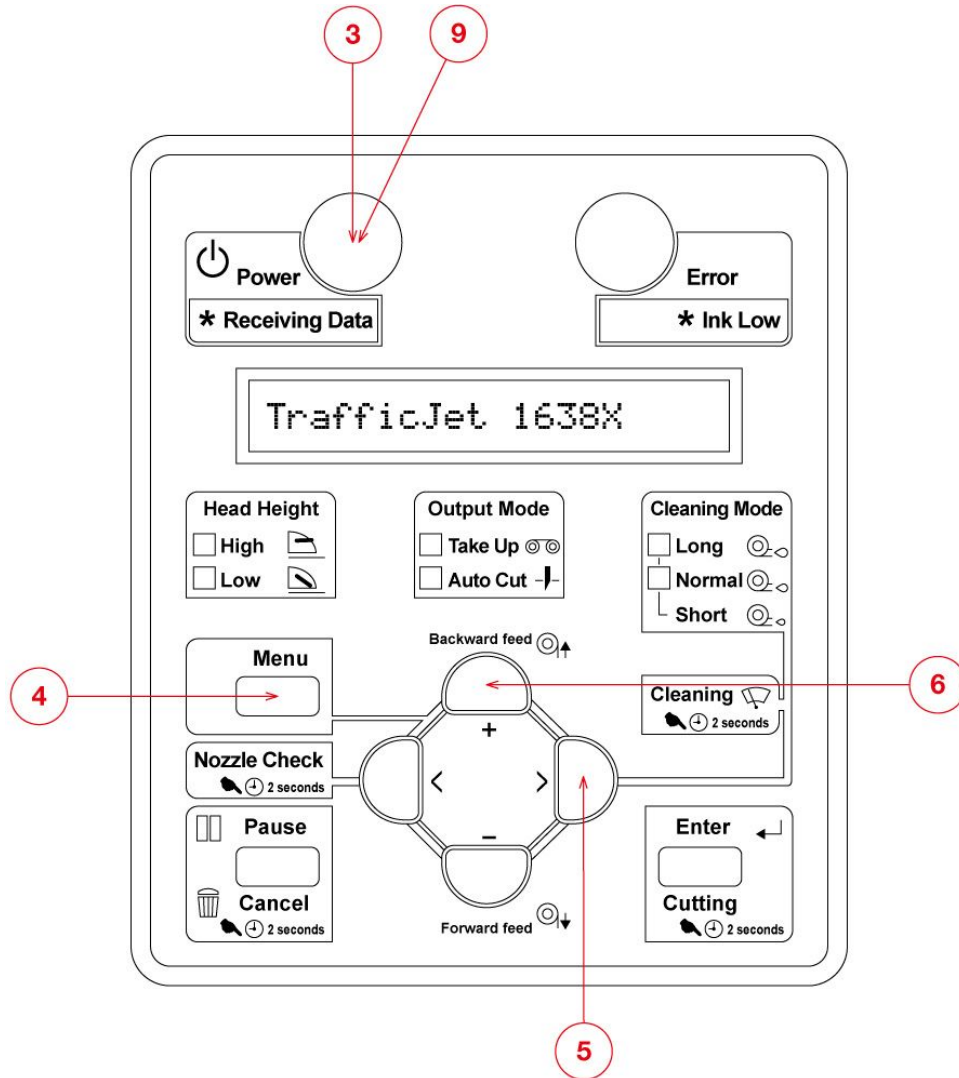
- 1 set (8 pc.) of 440ml cartridges or 950ml bags Flush
- Container to store the discharged ink and Flush
- Enough, non expired ink available to fill up the system again after the Long store period

IMPORTANT!

- Make sure all maintenance has been done properly, the cappings are in a good shape and that there are no clogs in the waste ink system
- **DO NOT** initiate a Longstore if ever expired inks were used

The Longstore Process

1. Perform Daily Maintenance (for more information about this topic, please visit reflectives.averydennison.com and read the document TrafficJet - Printer Maintenance IB# 9.2)
2. Make sure the Waste Ink Bottle is empty
3. Set the Head Height to the LOW position
4. Turn ON the printer
5. Press the Menu button
6. Press the Right Arrow button once
7. Press the Up Arrow button 12 times until you see Set 19: Longstore
8. Follow the on-screen instructions
 - a. Remove Ink Cartridges
 - b. Insert Cleaning Cartridges (Flush) when prompted
 - c. Remove Cleaning Cartridges (Flush) when prompted
 - d. Insert Cleaning Cartridges (Flush) when prompted
 - e. Remove Cleaning Cartridges (Flush) when prompted
9. Continue following on-screen instructions until you see [ALL]NoCartridge or [ALL]Discharged (depends upon machine type or firmware version)
10. Turn the printer OFF
