TrafficJet™ Holiday Season Printing Procedure

With the holidays approaching, it is time to prepare your TrafficJet printer for the reduction in print volume. It is important to plan for periods when you will not be printing for extended periods of time.

Recommendations

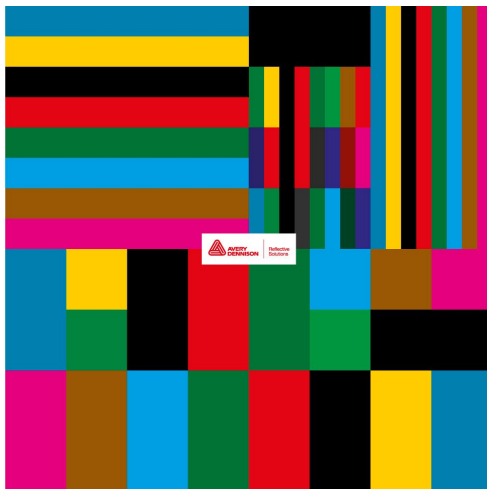
- Longstore
- Upkeep printing

Longstore involves replacing the ink cartridges and printer with flush. This prevents ink on the exposed printhead from reacting with air preventing ink from drying and blocking the nozzles. This is a very effective means of preparing your machine for an upcoming break, but comes at the expense of discharging ink in the lines, the cost of flush, and replacing ink in the lines when you are ready to resume printing.

IMPORTANT! Longstoring can only be initiated if proper maintenance (daily, weekly, monthly) has been performed all year and you have ensured yourself there are no clogs in the tubes.

An alternative to this method is to periodically operate the printer. This ensures that ink continues to flow through the lines, preventing ink buildup and eventually reacting with the air. By printing the following [linked file](#) once or twice per day, you can prevent possible damage to the printhead while at the same time avoid the expense of placing your machine in Longstore. The file has been designed to print using all inks and nozzles in the print head.



Your TrafficJet printer is an eco-solvent based printer. Printing all colors and channels ensures that ink is flowing through the lines and through the nozzles which will reduce the natural tendency of ink to collect and solidify in the nozzles. Instituting a policy to print regularly will help maintain your TrafficJet printer and reduce maintenance costs.
