Avery Dennison[®] TrafficJet[™] After Power outage

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If you have power supply issues or occasionally experience blackouts or power outages, then the following checklist will ensure your TrafficJet has the correct setup and ensures little downtime.

All of the settings below need to be checked and may not reset or change. The settings are on the TrafficJet front panel and are a guide only.

Any further quality issues after a power outage should be reported to your local Avery Dennison Technician immediately.

Here is the list of items to check and setup after a power outage on your TrafficJet printer.

1. User type

You will probably find your printer set to "TYPE 1". This most likely means your user and therefore media settings are lost. By connecting your computer directly to the printer (on some networks it doesn't work), your technical service representative will be able to rename them (not mandatory)

2. Thickness

Under every user type, the thickness should be set up.

On your printer panel go to:

Press Menu > Setup > Press Right Arrow > User type > Press Enter > Type X > Press Enter > Print mode > 8 x down arrow > thickness

With the UP and DOWN arrow you will be able to adjust the desired thickness.

Press Menu to escape from the Menu.

3. PF and temperature adjustments

The PF and temperatures values are managed by FLEXI.

4. Output mode

Your printer is equipped with a Take up system.

Pres Menu > Setup > Right arrow > User type > Press the DOWN arrow 5 times > Output mode > Press Enter > With the UP and DOWN arrow you will be able to select "Take up"

Press Menu to escape

5. Auto cleaning

Your printer has an auto cleaning cycle, depending the Anti static bar installed.

Please refer to your local Avery Dennison Technician for the model you have installed.

Press Menu > Setup > Right arrow > User type > Press the DOWN arrow 14 times > Auto cleaning > Press Enter > With the UP and DOWN arrow you will be able to adjust those settings.

Autoclean Settings : Waiting Time 1440 > Printing time (**30** for old 929 Bar, **90** for new 924 Bar, **0** if Bar is not installed or turned OFF), Before Printing OFF.*
