Ethernet Cable	: Cat5 or Cat6 from RIP PC to Printer (not included with the printer!)

Backup the preferences

Be aware that the exact file path on your computer can be slightly different!

- Close all your active FLEXI programs •
- Go to your C Drive, Program Files (x86), Avery Dennison, Mutoh or SAi, FLEXI or SAi product ٠ folder, Preference Manager
- Open this program and click save •
- Give your preferences backup file a good, descriptive name and we advise to add the date
- Click OK and click Export •
- Save this .pmf file to your server or external drive so you can easily access during the reinstall



Backup the presets

- Open Production Manager
- Go to your top menu and click File, Export Preset
- Select all presets you would like to backup (be aware that the ones not selected will be lost)
- Tick the box Embed input icc profiles
- Click Export and save the presets to your server or external drive so you can easily access during the reinstall

Deactivate FLEXI

- Close all your active FLEXI programs
- Go to your C Drive, Program Files (x86), Avery Dennison, Mutoh or SAi, FLEXI or SAi product folder, Licensemanager
- Write down the details or make a screenshot as you need this during downloading and reinstalling!
- Click Remove License From This Computer (important as if the license is still active, reinstalling is not possible!)
- Click finish

Uninstall FLEXI

- Close all your active FLEXI programs
- Go to your C Drive, Program Files (x86), Avery Dennison, Mutoh or SAi, FLEXI or SAi product folder, Uninstall FlexiPRINT Avery Dennison Edition (or the alternative name of your FLEXI product)
- Follow the steps of the uninstaller

Download FLEXI

- Go to <u>www.saicloud.com</u>
- Log in with your credentials that you created during the initial installation
- Look for the correct Software ID (the one you wrote down during the deactivation process)
- Click download

Reinstall FLEXI

- Click the installer in the package downloaded previously
- Follow the installation steps
- Once finished, add the FLEXI apps to the list of trusted apps in your (Windows) firewall
- We advise to switch off the pc's sleep or energy saving mode to prevent potential issues



Reinstall presets

- Open FLEXI Production Manager, go to the top menu, click File, Import Preset and import the presets from the location you previously used to back them up
- Click yes to all following questions in the dialog
- Close Production Manager

Reinstall preferences

Be aware that the exact file path on your computer can be slightly different!

- Close all your active FLEXI programs
- Go to your C Drive, Program Files (x86), Avery Dennison, Mutoh or SAi, FLEXI or SAi product folder, Preference Manager
- Click Import to import the .pmf file from the location you previously used to back it up
- Open Production Manager and ensure yourself the settings and environment are correct
- Open FlexiPRINT (designer) and ensure yourself the settings and environment are correct
